Re-read Exodus 1 together.

Describe in your own words how God's people, the Israelites, got to Egypt.

What is life like for them in Egypt at this point in the story?

What do you think it would be like, to live as an Israelite at this time in history... in captivity for 400+ years, longing for God to do something to change your circumstances?

Have you ever felt like this in your own life?

2. Who is Moses? Look at Exodus 2 to discover the answers
What nationality was Moses born into?

How did he end up as an adopted son in Pharos's house?

Who are 'his own people' referring to in Exodus 2:11

3. We sometimes get involved in the story when we think God isn't working fast enough. If we don't like the WHEN in God's plan, we try to get involved.

Why do you think Moses made sure no one was looking before he killed the Egyptians in Exodus 2:12? What might this say about Moses' awareness of whether his actions were wrong or right?

Have you ever gotten impatient with God's timing?

Share the overview of what happened when you got involved?

4. Sometimes we get involved in the story because we don't like the "HOW" God has for the plan.

Have you every tried to do things your way, rather than doing things God's way? How did that turn out?
