Spend time telling the group what area you want to hear God's invitation in this week. Then spend some time asking Jesus to help you notice the moments when he's inviting you to something: maybe he'll invite you to have a new perspective, to vent your anger to God rather than let it out on a person. Maybe He will invite you to help someone, or he'll invite you to pause. Let's ask God for help and see what He has in store this week.
