### **CHECK-IN HOURS // ARRIVAL INFO**

Check in begins at 4pm and is located in the Ironhorse (Red Roof) Building. Check in will remain open till 6:30pm and then open again at 9pm after 1<sup>st</sup> session.

Feel free to head up to Williams early, however the campgrounds open at **4pm and no earlier.**
