### GETTING TO KNOW YOU

1. Growing up, what was your greatest fear? Here are a few examples: the dark, the boogie man, bad dreams costumes/mascots or maybe the dentist.
2. As an adult, what is it that you’re afraid of or what just creeps you out?

### QUICK REVIEW

Looking back at your notes from this week’s teaching, was there anything that particularly caught your attention, challenged or confused you?

### DIGGING DEEPER

1. Aaron explained how God’s Law reveals our guilt. He used the story of a women caught in adultery from John 8. Jesus’ message to her accusers were that ALL are guilty of sin. Read Romans 3:22-23; 1 John 1:8, 10. What do these scriptures say about our guiltiness?

Share a time when you were younger and you were caught doing something you should not have been doing. How is the feeling of guilt as a child different from the guilt you feel now as an adult?

2. Aaron stated, *“Until we see ourselves as a sinner we will never see a need for a Savior.”* Do you see this as a true? Why or why not? Read Romans 6:23. What does this verse tell us about the consequences of our sin? Does this seem too drastic, especially if we are only guilty of little sins?

3. Aaron stated, *“God’s Love reveals His grace.”* Read Romans 5:8-10; John 3:16-17. What do these verses tell us about God’s grace and forgiveness?

If we have been justified and forgiven, if our slate is clean in the eyes of God, how does He now see us? Read Romans 8:1; John 1:12; Galatians 3:26; 2 Corinthians 5:17.

4. Read Psalm 139:1- 18. King David, the author of this Psalm, exclaims in great detail how well God knows him even from before his birth. God, knowing EVERYTHING about David, which includes being a murderer and an adulterer, still loved David and died for him. What are some things you wonder if God can ever forgive

What have you struggled with forgiving others for?

5. The first week of this current series Linn asked you to write down the names of three people you were going to choose to be the ONE whom you would invite to church. Who are they? What is your plan to accomplish this task?

### TAKING IT HOME

Before you invite a friend, family member or neighbor to church spend some time in prayer for that person. Ask that God would begin to mold and condition their heart for your encounter. If they say NO, that’s OK. YOU were obedient in doing so. Give it a try.
